**Free subscription to the
Scandinavian Journal of Immunology
for the calendar year 2009**

We have the pleasure of informing you that the *Scandinavian Journal of Immunology* also this year will offer free subscriptions to the *Journal* for paying members of the *SSI* with a nominal fee for postage. The understanding is that this is a free copy that can only be used personally and not for library or other general purposes. Our very generous offer can only be made as long as it does not affect library or other paid subscriptions. It can only be used for Scandinavian Society members, living and working in Scandinavia, unless other special arrangements have been made with the Editorial Office in Bergen. To establish a procedure similar to other societies, e.g. the British Society for Immunology, the Council of the *SSI* has decided that the *Journal* will only be sent to members who have paid their dues for the coming year.

The member should fill in the form, stating that they wish to obtain the *Journal*. We require both work and home addresses. We must stress that the *Journal* will **only be sent to home addresses**. This is the requirement from Blackwell for sending out free copies, so therefore there will be no personal copies sent to laboratories or institutions. We also require your work address, - telephone and -fax numbers and e-mail in order to update our *SSI* directory. Information will be returned to Kate Frøland, *Scandinavian Journal of Immunology*, Broegelmann Research Laboratory, Armauer Hansen Bldg., N-5021 Bergen by **the 14th April 2008**. Requests for the *Journal* arriving after this date will be handled towards the publisher bimonthly, but late requests will not be effected with back issues. The postage fee of NOK 65,- should be sent together with the membership dues directly to the Norwegian Society for Immunology.
